

Master of Science - Non-Thesis (M.S.-NT Option) - FORM 2

This degree requires a **minimum of 30 credits, including a minimum 24 credits of regular letter graded coursework**

- At least **15 credits** must be from courses in the Horticultural Sciences major.
- Coursework taken for program credit must be numbered 5000 or higher.
- Up to 6 credits of S/U graded courses may count towards total 30 credit requirement.
- Up to 6 credits of undergraduate courses (3000-4999) outside of the major may be used for Foundational or Supporting Coursework when taken as part of an approved graduate program¹.

¹Subject to Graduate School policy change.

At least 6 credits of coursework are required if a minor is chosen. A student must maintain a minimum GPA of 3.0 in their minor for the minor to be valid.

All graduate students must enroll in the following courses:

- ALS 5934 (Graduate Professional Development) during their first fall semester
- HOS 6931 (Horticultural Science Seminar) typically during first spring semester
- HOS 6940 (Supervised Teaching) at least once during their program of study.
